

Owl Walkie Talkie

Steps ↓

- 1 Clean 2 tin cans and remove the labels
- 2 Wrap paper around each can, trim and tape in place, then decorate with owl drawings
- 3 Ask an adult to hammer a single nail hole into the base of each can
- 4 From the outside of the tin, thread one end of the string through the small hole, then tie a knot big enough to stop it from slipping back through
- 5 With the other end of the string, repeat previous step on the second can
- 6 Ask a friend to hold the other can to their ear then speak into the can (keeping the string taut). Your friend should be able to hear you!

What you'll need: ✓

- 2x empty tin cans
- Piece of string (1-3 metres)
- Paper and pens to decorate
- Scissors and tape
- Hammer and a nail



Did you know?

Tawny owls have one ear lower than the other ear, which helps them to hear really well - a useful skill for hunting in the dark.
